Fire Action

- Try to **put the fire out**, using the **correct tools** (e.g. hose, fire blanket)
- Leave the building if it seems unsafe

Anyone who sees smoke should:

- Report it straightaway
- Find out where the smoke is coming from if it seems safe
- Leave the building if it seems unsafe

Anyone who hears the alarm should:

- Leave the building by the safest route
- Follow the signs or directions from staff
- Not use lifts. Always use the stairs
- Go to the agreed Assembly Point outside of the building. This is the safe place to meet in case of a fire

Cycle safety



Cycling is an easy and fun way to get around the local area.

Before you cycle

- Dress to be seen easily
 - o You should wear bright clothes to cycle
 - o You should have lights on your bike
- Always wear a helmet. Check that it fits. It should be comfortable, cover your forehead
 and the sides and back of your head, and not move around

Check your bike

- Make sure that your **tyres** are **pumped up**. They should **not** appear worn
- Check everything is working properly. You can cycle a short distance to check the brakes

During your cycle

- Ride in the correct place. Cycle carefully at the side of the road
- Follow the road rules
- Stay alert. Do not use earphones or headphones

After you cycle

- Park your bike carefully
- Lock your bike. Make sure it is safe. Leave it where it can be seen
