Sascha's appointment time was **9.25am**.

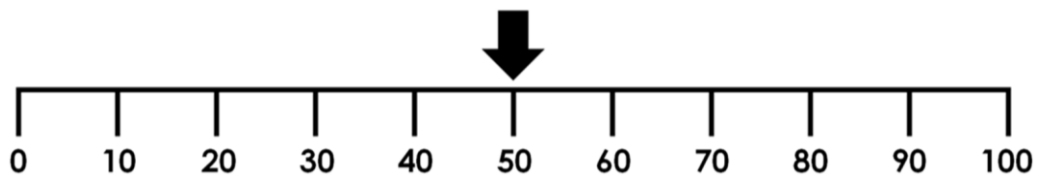
Question 5

Sascha is given these tablets:



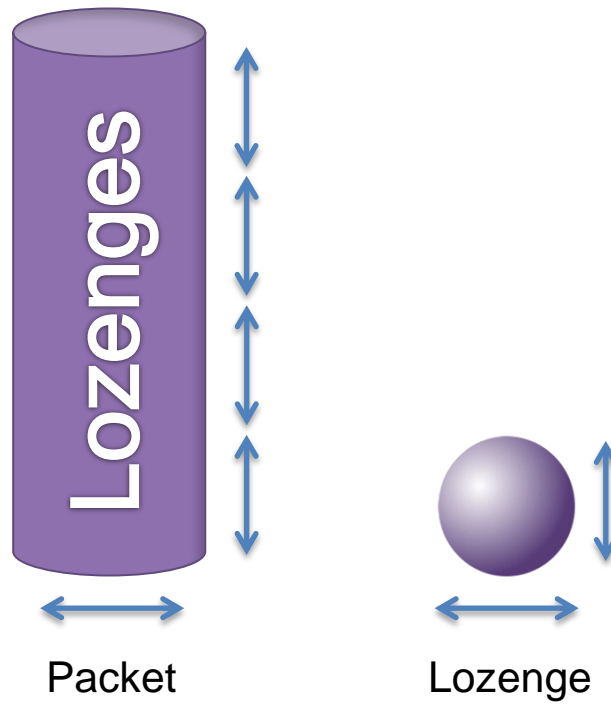
Question 9
