- Open Awards can generate a Learner Achievement Report. The report is a source of reference and records your achievement accomplished through Open Awards for a particular course. If you are intending to use the report to apply for a job or enter Higher Education you may find that some employers or universities require an original certificate and may not accept this report as evidence of your achievement.
- The report is in a PDF format and will be sent to you electronically via email.
   The report will show your name, course title, centre name and unit details. If you have completed an Access to HE course it will also show the module and grade details.
