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# Being an Open Awards Approved Provider

#### Apply to Become an Open Awards Provider

To deliver Open Awards qualifications, units or programmes, you will need to complete a provider approval process. All Open Awards providers are fully supported through the approval process by our experienced team. If you are ready to apply to be approved by Open Awards, please complete the <a href="New Business Enquiry Form">New Business Enquiry Form</a> or contact the team on 0151 494 2072 or <a href="enquiries@openawards.org.uk">enquiries@openawards.org.uk</a>.

The Provider Approval Fee is a one-off fee to cover the cost of the review of your application. The fee includes dedicated support with producing and reviewing the required policies and procedures; curriculum planning support; and producing an action plan collaboratively.

Once approved, providers will be invoiced for the Annual Provider Recognition Fee (pro rata'd for the number of months remaining in the academic year).

## **Annual Provider Recognition Fee**

All approved providers pay an annual provider recognition fee. This is based on the number of learner registrations from the previous academic year (1<sup>st</sup> August – 31<sup>st</sup> July). This fee gives you access to online quality and compliance training activities; ongoing curriculum planning support; and advice and guidance from a dedicated Quality and Standards Advisor.

The annual recognition fee will be pro-rata'd in the first year.
