	1.2 Select appropriate tools
	1.3 Identify and remove any debris, including plant species impeding the path line as directed
	1.4 Accurately and clearly mark out the path line and width to specification
	1.5 Excavate the path, removing any waste material as directed
	1.6 Fit edging boards and revetment as required
	1.7 Lay hardcore evenly to a specified thickness, levelling and consolidating as directed
	1.8 Lay surface material evenly to a specified thickness and consolidate
	1.9 Repair any environmental damage
	1.10 Remove arisings/debris from the area using correct methods of disposal, leaving the site clear, tidy, safe and in good condition
2. Be able to maintain footpaths	2.1 Check the condition of footpath and structures for safety and condition

2.2 Resurface a footpath as directed using appropriate tools and materials

2.3 Clear drains of obstructing debris and vegetation to maintain correct fall

2.4 Repair or replace edging as required

2.5 Repair any environmental damage

2.6 Remove arisings/debris from the area using correct methods of disposal, leaving the site clear, tidy, safe and in good condition
