## Indicative Content

LO1	The Journal Quilt should demonstrate a redesign or re-sizing of a block or blocks, using mathematical principles to fit precise measurements. It should create a pleasing design and should also demonstrate learning from previous modules.
LO2	In their personal Journal the learner should demonstrate how to select materials and estimate quantities, how to produce professional estimates for commissioned work; how to price a quilt for sale. How to define a sequence of processes for construction.
LO3	The learner should demonstrate an understanding of cost and supply needs and should demonstrate critical evaluation of the final result in terms of design and workmanship.
LO4	In their personal journal the learner should have provided illustrations of at least two quilts and have done the calculations to be able to provide a price for (imagined) sale.
