## Indicative Content

LO1	Learners should understand the various methods of finishing a quilt. Learners should also understand when embellishments add or even detract from the overall appearance of a finished quilt.
LO2	Learners should know how to select the most appropriate method for particular quilts. They should know how to ensure that a quilt hangs flat and exhibition-ready, including strong and secure hanging sleeves and the importance of quilt labels.
LO3	In the production of the Journal Quilt, the learner should demonstrate an awareness that finishing a quilt is important to its overall design and impact. The finish should enhance the design selected and should produce accurate and neat edges and corners. The finish of the back of the quilt will be taken into consideration in assessment.
